

LIQUID TANKER

PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY!

Assembly

EXAMINE CONTENTS CAREFULLY FOR ALL PARTS BEFORE ASSEMBLY

1 Hatch Covers

Hold the hatch covers vertically, as shown, and push hinge down over projections next to the hatches.

2 Side Catwalk

The six projections on the catwalk fit into the six slots along the tanker body, just push firmly in until they snap in place.

3 Ladder

Engage the two pins at top of ladder with the holes in the two bosses under the catwalk, then push the lower pins on ladder firmly into the holes in side of tanker.

4 Mounting on Basic Trailer

Remove "I" sides and front stop panel from trailer. Pull back SURE-LOCK (license plate bracket) on trailer, engage hooks at front of tanker into the two square holes at front of trailer at an angle as shown, lower the rear of tanker so that the two metal projections fall into the two holes at rear of trailer, then push SURE-LOCK back in.

5 Auxiliary Engine

Press pins under engine into the two holes exposed on the rear of the trailer.

6 Fenders

Put fenders over the rear trailer wheels. Push square projections into the square holes in sides of trailer directly over wheels.

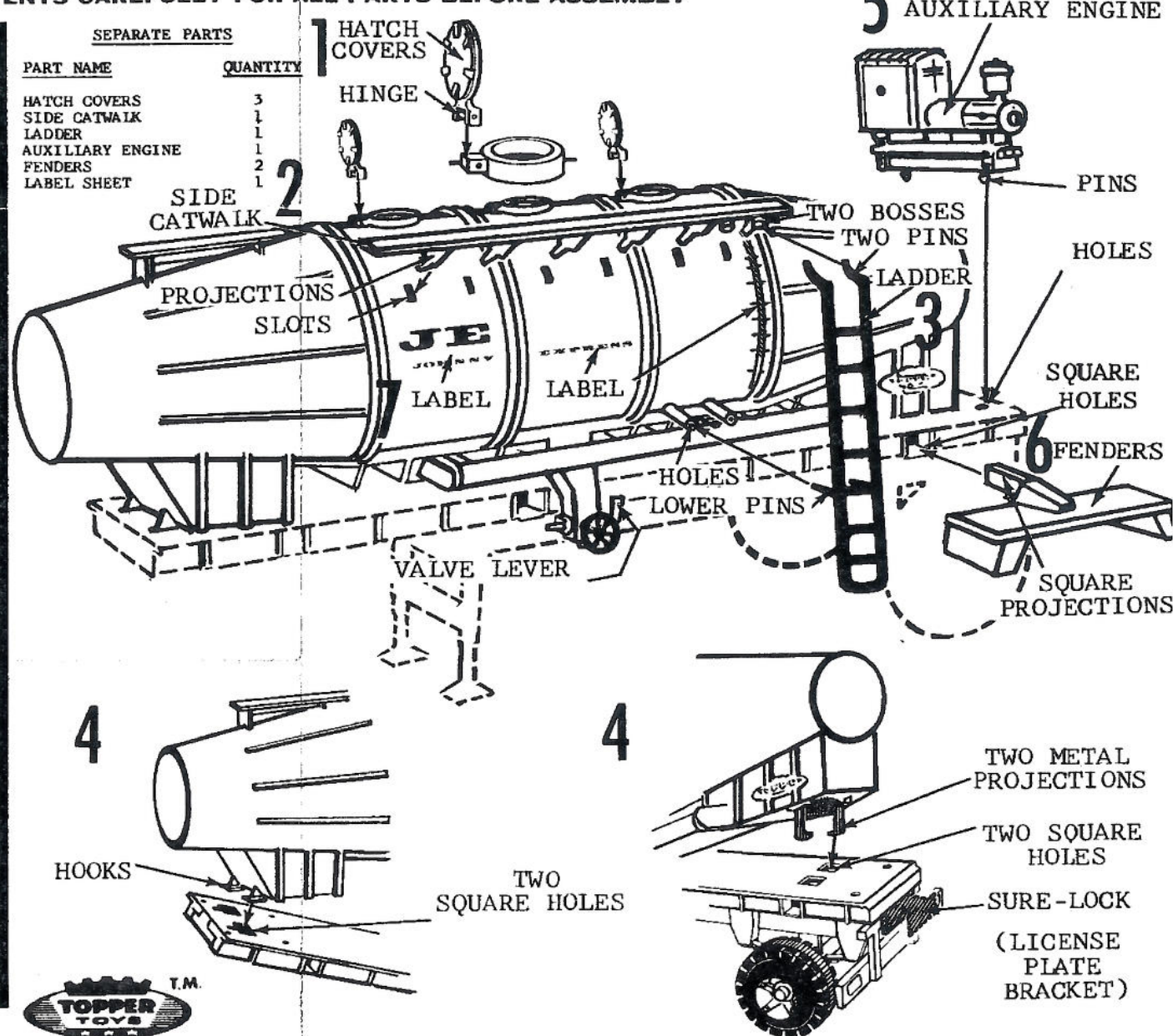
7 Labels

Carefully peel off labels and place labels directly above ribs.

Operation

This unit actually holds water. Swing open the center hatch, pour in approximately one pint of water and close hatch. Push valve lever down to release water - up to shut it off.

The Liquid Tanker is designed to work with the Johnny Express Storage Tank. When used with the Storage Tank, lift up center hatch on Tanker, BACK UP under Storage Tank, and fill. Then drive FORWARD and close hatch.
